THE MACEDONIAN By Petro Aleksowski

11.15 - 12.30 - Participation in person

In 1946 the Greek Communist Party approached Socialist European countries with a request to accept children evacuated from wartorn Greece and give them a home. 3500 children were brought to Poland. Macedonians inhabiting the northern parts of Greece constituted more than half of all the children. Among them was small Mito Aleksowski – the director's father. "The Macedonian" is about 1,750 Macedonian children before whom Greece closed its borders and remain so until this day. Duration 59 min., Poland 2023.



SPEAKING THE UNSPEAKABLE: IN THE AFTERMATH OF WEAPONIZED RAPE IN TIGRAY By Thera Mjaaland

The Tigray War (2020–2022) was the result of a political conflict between the federal government of Ethiopia and the Tigray Regional Government. The war soon developed into a campaign of ethnic cleansing of the population of Tigray. As weapons of war, thousands of girls and women, as well as some boys and men, were sexually abused, sometimes for days and weeks. The victims still waiting for justice and redress. THE BORDER: RESISTING MONOCULTURES IN CENTRAL ITALY By Alexander Koensler


14.25 - 15:00 - Participation in person

14.20 - 15:00 - Online participation


